### RESTRICTIONS LIFTED FOR REOPENING!

On Tues., June 15 California lifted COVID-19 restrictions for most businesses. After 15 months this is very exciting news! What does it mean for PCN? Fully vaccinated individuals are no longer required to wear masks indoors. Capacity limits have been lifted - there is no need to reserve your spot. Taking visitors' temperatures is not required. We no longer need to socially distance - so goodbye pool noodles! We will resume serving coffee on the patio!

Unvaccinated individuals must continue to wear masks indoors; this includes unvaccinated children. Please adhere to this rule to protect those unable to receive the vaccine.
